



STATE OF ALABAMA
PROCLAMATION
BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, on October 6, 2017, in response to Hurricane Nate, I proclaimed a State of Emergency pursuant to the Alabama Emergency Management Act of 1955, as amended, due to conditions of disaster and of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the State; and

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of officials at the Alabama Emergency Management Agency and after consultation with other affected persons and entities, it has been determined that such conditions no longer exist in the State of Alabama;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of the State of Alabama, do hereby pronounce that the State of Emergency declared on October 6, 2017, is terminated, effective 12:00 a.m. on October 11, 2017.

BE IT ORDERED that the appropriate Alabama state agencies are hereby instructed to resume their normal state of business and day-to-day operations.
