# 680-X-2-.33 Internet Pharmacies.

Before dispensing a prescription, a A pharmacist shall make every reasonable effort to ensure that any order, regardless of the means of transmission, has been issued for a legitimate medical purpose by an authorized practitioner. A pharmacist shall not dispense a prescription drug if the pharmacist has knowledge, or reasonably should have known under the circumstances, that the order for such drug was issued on the basis of an internet-based questionnaire, an internet-based consultation, or a telephonic consultation, all without and pursuant to a valid preexisting patient-practitioner relationship.
