1. MOTIONS

A motion to adopt the agenda was made by Dr. Cobb and seconded by Ms. Giles. A vote was taken and the motion to approve the agenda passed unanimously. No nays or abstentions recorded.

A motion was made by Ms. Giles and seconded by Dr. Cobb to approve the November 18, 2025, hearing minutes. A vote was taken and the motion to approve the October 14, 2025, hearing minutes passed with aye votes from Dr. Cobb, Ms. Giles, Mr. Brooklere, and Dr. Hicks. No nays or abstentions recorded.

2. INCOMING BOARD MEMBER OATHS

Hearing Officer Jim Hampton administered the oath of office to incoming Board members Alecia Booker and Darrelle Knight.

3. DISCIPLINARY HEARING

Disciplinary case 23-L-0337 was heard by Board members virtually beginning at 8:36 a.m. and concluding at 9:19 a.m. Disciplinary case 25-0125 was heard by Board members beginning at 9:28 a.m. and concluding at 10:10 a.m.

4. EXECUTIVE SESSION

A motion was made by Dr. Cobb and seconded by Mr. Brooklere to enter executive session for the five Board members to deliberate on disciplinary cases heard today. Ms. Neumann certified as a member in good standing of the Alabama State Bar that the purpose for the executive session is to deliberate on disciplinary cases heard today. An individual voice vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously. No nays or abstentions recorded. The executive session will begin at 10:20 a.m. and the Board will return to the public hearing at 10:35 a.m. The hearing was recessed at 10:16 a.m. and the public hearing resumed at 10:38 a.m.

A motion was then made by Mr. Brooklere and seconded by Dr. Cobb to enter executive session for the five Board members, along with Mr. Linna, Ms. Neumann, and Mr. Shaw, to discuss resolving cases. Ms. Neumann clarified they would be discussing pending cases that could result in settlement of matters in anticipation of litigation. An individual voice vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously. No nays or abstentions recorded. The executive session will begin at 10:45 a.m. and the Board will return to the public hearing at 11:00 a.m. The hearing was recessed at 10:40 a.m. and the public hearing resumed at 11:44 a.m.

A motion was made by Dr. Cobb and seconded by Ms. Giles in cases 25-0132, 25-0202, 25-0203, 25-0206, 25-0207, 25-0211, and 25-0215, of no violation. A vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously. No nays or abstentions recorded.

A motion was made by Dr. Cobb and seconded by Ms. Giles in cases 25-0213, 25-0227, 25-0229, 25-0234, 25-0235, 25-0241, 25-0245, and 25-0269, to accept surrender. A vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously. No nays or abstentions recorded.

A motion was made by Dr. Cobb and seconded by Ms. Giles in case 25-0226 to accept surrender and initiate a statement of charges. A vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously. No nays or abstentions recorded.

An individual voice vote was taken and the motion to accept the settlement offers in case numbers 23-L-0052 and 24-0232 passed unanimously. No nays or abstentions recorded.

8. EXECUTIVE SESSION

A vote was taken and the motion to deny with Board staff requesting her to withdraw her application and may reapply in one year passing unanimously. No nays or abstentions recorded.
