1. ROLL CALL

Executive Secretary Jon Linna called the roll. All nine Board members were present and a quorum was established.

2. INVOCATION

The invocation was given by Mr. Brooklere.

3. AGENDA

A motion was made by Ms. Giles and seconded by Mr. Brooklere to adopt the agenda. A vote was taken and the motion to adopt the agenda passed unanimously. No nays or abstentions recorded.

4. DISCIPLINARY HEARINGS

The following disciplinary case numbers were heard by the Board beginning at 8:08 a.m. and ending at 9:08 a.m.: 20-L-0123, 25-0292, 25-0291, and 25-0318.

5. HEARING MINUTES

A motion was made by Ms. Giles and seconded by Mr. Brooklere to approve the May 19, 2026, hearing minutes. A vote was taken and the motion to approve the May 19, 2026, hearing minutes passed unanimously. No nays or abstentions recorded.

6. EXECUTIVE SESSION

A motion was made by Ms. Giles and seconded by Dr. Hicks to enter executive session for the purpose of the nine Board members to deliberate on disciplinary cases. Mr. Dettling certified that deliberation of contested disciplinary cases is proper for executive session. An individual voice vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously. No nays or abstentions recorded. The executive session will begin at 9:20 a.m. and the Board will return to the public hearing at 9:45 a.m. The hearing was recessed at 9:09 a.m. and the public hearing resumed at 9:56 a.m.

7. CASE REVIEW COMMITTEE

A vote was taken and the motion for no further violation passed with aye votes from Dr. Cobb, Mr. Brooklere, Dr. Hicks, Dr. Marbury, Dr. Mitchell, Judge Stokes, Ms. Booker, and Dr. Pinner. Dr. Hicks abstained. No nays recorded.

A motion of no violation was made by Dr. Hicks and seconded by Ms. Giles in case numbers 25-0102, 26-0070, and 26-0077. A vote was taken and the motion of no violation passed unanimously. No nays or abstentions recorded.

A motion for no further action was made by Dr. Hicks and seconded by Ms. Giles in case numbers 25-0077, 26-0074, 26-0075, 26-0078, 26-0083, 26-0088, 26-0090, and 26-0091. A vote was taken and the motion for no further action passed unanimously. No nays or abstentions recorded.

A motion to issue a letter of concern and corrective action was made by Dr. Hicks and seconded by Ms. Giles in case numbers 26-0080, 26-0084, and 26-0093. A vote was taken and the motion for no further action passed unanimously. No nays or abstentions recorded.

8. RECESS

A recess was taken from 10:10 a.m. to 1:01 p.m.

A motion was made by Mr. Brooklere and seconded by Ms. Giles to enter executive session for the purpose of the nine Board members to deliberate on applicant cases. Mr. Dettling certified that deliberation of contested cases is appropriate for executive session. An individual voice vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously. No nays or abstentions recorded. The executive session will begin at 2:00 p.m. and the Board will return to the public hearing at 2:15 p.m. The hearing was recessed at 1:53 p.m. and the public hearing resumed at 2:19 p.m.

11. MOTIONS ON APPEARANCES

A motion was made by Dr. Hicks and seconded by Mr. Brooklere to grant the applications in case numbers 26-0034 and 26-0106. A vote was taken and the motion to grant passed unanimously. No nays or abstentions recorded.

A motion was made by Dr. Hicks and seconded by Mr. Brooklere to grant the application in case number 26-0109. A vote was taken and the motion to grant the application passed with aye votes from Mr. Brooklere, Dr. Mitchell, Ms. Booker, and Dr. Cobb. Ms. Giles, Dr. Marbury, Judge Stokes, and Dr. Pinner voted nay. No abstentions recorded.

A motion was made by Dr. Hicks and seconded by Mr. Brooklere to deny the application in case number 26-0120. A vote was taken and the motion to deny the application passed with aye votes from Dr. Cobb, Mr. Brooklere, Dr. Hicks, Dr. Mitchell, and Ms. Booker. Ms. Giles, Dr. Marbury, Judge Stokes, and Dr. Pinner voted nay. No abstentions recorded.
