Adopted without changes. I. Background

Notices of Intended Action for the above rules were filed with the Legislative Services Agency on June 17, 2026. The Board received two written comments during the comment period: a comment dated August 12, 2026 ("Commenter 1"), and a comment dated August 14, 2026 ("Commenter 2"). A public hearing was held August 19, 2026. In accordance with Ala. Code § 41-22-5(a)(2), the Board has considered all written and oral submissions received and sets forth below its principal reasons for and against adoption of the proposed rules, including its reasons for overruling the considerations urged against adoption.

As a preliminary and general observation applicable throughout this statement: Act 2025-372 substantially altered the Board's monetary penalty authority as compared to prior law. Former Ala. Code § 34-23-90(a)(12) authorized the Board to "invoke penalties not to exceed the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for each violation" under a general, undefined standard. Act 2025-372 repealed that provision in its entirety and replaced it with the current framework in § 34-23-33(b), which requires that the Board adopt "dollar amount ranges based on the underlying violation," differentiated by categories of licensees including, but not limited to, chain pharmacies, independent pharmacies, manufacturers, and distributors. The Legislature did not itself define "violation," "chain pharmacy," "independent pharmacy," "level and scope of misconduct," or "level of risk to public health and safety" – terms it used and left to the Board's discretion in § 34-23-33(b)(3). The lodestar scoring methodology, the associated point bands, and the written-statement requirement for departures exceeding fifteen percent in proposed Rule 680-X-2-.50(2)(e) are not required by statute; they reflect the Board's voluntary effort to bring greater transparency, consistency, and predictability to an exercise of discretion that the Legislature otherwise

committed to the Board's case-by-case judgment. This context informs the Board's responses below.

II. Action Taken

The Board adopts proposed Rule 680-X-2-.50 and proposed Chapter 680-X-A as noticed on June 17, 2026, without change. The Board declines to make any changes to the proposed rules at this time, for the reasons stated below, while acknowledging that certain comments may warrant consideration in a future rulemaking cycle.

III. Response to Comments

A. Commenter 1 (Aug. 12, 2026)

1. Definition of "Violator"

Commenter 1 observes that proposed Rule 680-X-2-.50(d) uses the term "compliance history of the violator" without an express definition of the term "violator," and expresses concern that the disciplinary history of a single pharmacy location could be attributed to other, unrelated locations under common ownership. The Board declines to add a definition. The Board considers the term "violator" to have its plain and commonly-understood meaning: "violator" refers to the particular permit or license holder that is found, after due process, to have committed the disciplinary infraction at issue. Compliance history accordingly attaches to that specific permit or license holder and not, without more, to other permits or licenses held by a common owner or affiliate. No amendment to the rule is necessary. The Board also declines to implement Commenter 1's further suggestion of a fixed lookback period (e.g., five years) for prior violations. That suggestion, and the balance of Commenter 1's comments addressed below, may be considered in a future rulemaking cycle once the Board has practical experience administering the lodestar methodology.

2. Risk and Culpability Scoring Standards; Actual vs. Potential Harm (Issues #2 and #3)

Commenter 1 notes that the lodestar methodology allocates half of the scoring weight to the statutory factor of "level of risk to public health and safety" and acknowledges that the Board has established written benchmarks and point ranges to guide the Board's decisionmaking. Commenter 1 requests that the Board add even greater specificity to these benchmarks, including more detailed "objective definitions, scoring criteria, and illustrative examples." Section 34-23-33(b) (3) directs the Board to consider "the level and scope of misconduct" and "the level of risk to public health and safety" using the same open-textured language the proposed rule adopts, without further legislative definition. The lodestar framework in Rule 680-X-2-.50(2)(e) is designed to add a measure of structure and transparency to a discretionary judgment the statute otherwise leaves to the Board. Further codifying precise numeric definitions for every scoring band might be desirable, but also may not be feasible given the great variety of cases and fact patterns that are involved in each individual case. The Board finds these comments may have merit as considerations for future refinement after the Board gains experience applying the lodestar methodology, and may consider them at that time.

3. Written Findings for Scoring Determinations and Departures

Next, Commenter 1 argues that "the Board's transparency objectives would be significantly enhanced by requiring written findings identifying: • The score assigned in each category; • The facts supporting each score; • Any aggravating or mitigating factors considered; and • The basis for any departure from the calculated penalty amount." Although not expressly stated in the text of the Rule, as a matter of administrative

implementation, in contested cases in which a civil penalty is imposed, the Board intends to document the basis for each component score and the resulting lodestar calculation on a worksheet prepared in the particular contested case, which worksheet will be part of the administrative record in that particular case. This administrative implementation practice will provide much of the documentation Commenter 1 seeks.

4. Published Methodology for Penalty Ranges (680-X-A)

Lastly, Commenter 1 requests an explanation of the methodology used to establish the civil penalty ranges embodied in 680-X-A. The Board notes that the final proposed ranges were developed and discussed in properly noticed public meetings, at which interested persons had the opportunity to attend and to be heard. The Board discussed the proposed schedules at public meetings held on May 18 and 20, 2026, and placed the proposed civil penalty schedules on the Board's web site on June 8, 2026, all in advance of the first Board vote to initiate the rulemaking process. The present notice-and-comment process is further designed and intended to solicit public input on the ranges embodied in the schedules. The Board's Economic Impact Statement further explains, at a general level, that the schedules are designed and intended to promote "transparency (licensees can ascertain in advance the range of monetary exposure associated with any disciplinary violation), greater consistency and proportionality in penalty amounts, and deterrence of conduct that endangers public health and safety." In compliance with Act 2025-372, the schedules are further separated by license type and are therefore calibrated to structural differences among segments of the regulated market.

B. Commenter 2 (Aug. 14, 2026)

As a preliminary matter, substantial portions of Commenter 2's submission are directed at the Board's motives and general enforcement history rather than at the text of the proposed rules. Ala. Code § 41-22-5(a)(2) calls for a statement of the Board's reasons for and against adoption of the rule; the Board does not respond point-by-point to characterizations of its institutional conduct and confines this statement to the substantive points bearing on the proposed rules.

1. The Lodestar Scoring Rubric

In Contrast to Commenter 1, Commenter 2 characterizes the lodestar scoring rubric as not merely as lacking sufficient specificity, but as unauthorized and unlawful. The Board disagrees. Section 34-23-33(b)(3) prescribes three statutory factors the Board must consider in determining the amount of a monetary penalty – the level and scope of misconduct, the level of risk to public health and safety, and the compliance history of the violator – but leaves to the Board's administrative discretion how that directive is carried out. The lodestar methodology is simply the means by which the Board exercises that discretion: it structures the Board's consideration of the three statutory factors, assigns them defined relative weights, and creates qualitative "Advisory Anchors" to guide the Board's assignment of points. In the Board's view, a structured, transparent approach of this kind is far superior to an undefined, undocumented, and potentially arbitrary exercise of case-by-case discretion. In addition, the lodestar method focuses the Board's attention on the three statutory factors driving the imposition of civil penalties, to the exclusion of other non-statutory factors, such as the size of a business or its annual revenues.

2. Breadth of Penalty Ranges—Ranges "Far Out of Line with What the Legislature Intended"

Commenter 2 next contends that that the civil penalty ranges in 680-X-A

are "far out of line with what the Legislature intended." As discussed above, in Act 2025-372, the Legislature repealed the Board's former authority to impose fines of up to \$1,000 for each violation, and replaced it with the requirement that the Board establish civil penalty ranges "based on the underlying violation" and differentiated by license category. Act 2025-372 does not prescribe any minimum floor or maximum width. In accordance with Act 2025-372, each schedule entry sets a distinct ceiling tied to a specific violation and licensee category, which is itself the differentiation the statute requires. A zero floor for each prescribed range preserves the Board's discretion to account for genuinely minor or technical instances of a violation, consistent with the proportionality objectives Act 2025-372 was intended to serve. A zero floor in each case also explicitly preserves the Board's discretion to impose no civil penalty at all in any case in which the Board does not believe a civil penalty is appropriate.

3. Differential Ceilings for Manufacturers and Distributors

Commenter 2 contends that the Board's penalty schedules "fail[] to honor the no-size/no-revenue statutory directive." Section 34-23-33(b) (2) requires the Board to adopt "separate penalty schedules for specific types or categories of persons," naming chain pharmacies, independent pharmacies, manufacturers, and distributors. The differentiated ceilings among these named categories implement that express directive; they are not an unauthorized proxy for the size-of-business or annual-revenue factor that the Legislature separately removed from the case-specific scoring factors in the bill that became Act 2025-372 (see HB 123 (enrolled), lines 449-451).

4. Authority to Penalize Unlicensed Entities (§ 34-23-32(g))

Commenter 2 urges that the civil penalty schedules should not include the \$4,000-per-violation civil penalty found in Ala. Code § 34-23-32(g). The referenced \$4,000 civil penalty is imposed directly by § 34-23-32(g) for shipping a legend drug or device into this state without a valid Board-issued permit. Section 680-X-A-4 and -5's cross-reference to § 34-23-32(g) merely restates an existing statutory penalty, which must be accounted for in a complete civil penalty schedule regardless of whether, or against whom, the Board might ever impose it. The task before the Board in this rulemaking is to compile a schedule of potential civil penalties, not to pre-adjudicate whether any particular penalty can or will be imposed in a future case.

5. Undefined Unit of Violation; No Aggregate Cap

Next, Commenter 2 argues that "nothing in the rule or the schedules clearly defines what constitutes a single violation. . . ." The Board disagrees. The unit of violation is clearly addressed in subsections (f) and (g) of Rule 680-X-2-.50. These subsections establish that when multiple legal violations arise from the same underlying conduct, transaction, series of transactions, occurrence, or series of occurrences, the fines for multiple legal violations must be assessed concurrently rather than cumulatively. Subsections (f) and (g) are not part of the current rule amendment process; they are existing provisions of the rule that the pending rulemaking proceeding does not propose to alter.

6. Compliance History Blending Disciplinary and Non-Disciplinary Matters

Next, Commenter 2 contends that non-disciplinary administrative penalties should not be considered as part of the "compliance history of the violator." Section 34-23-33(b) (3) directs the Board to consider "the compliance history of the violator" without qualification, and nothing in the statute forbids consideration of prior non-disciplinary administrative

finer as part of that history. As discussed in Section III.A.1 above, compliance history attaches to the specific permit or license holder found to have committed the violation at issue.

7. "Undefined" Schedule Entries ("Refer to Corresponding Schedule")

Commenter 2 says that the schedule entries that read "Refer to corresponding schedule" are self-referential. These entries specify that when disciplinary action is grounded in Ala. Code § 34-23-33(a) (7) ("[v]iolation of any provisions contained in this chapter or a rule of the board"), the applicable civil penalty range is the range found elsewhere in the applicable schedule corresponding to the statute or rule allegedly violated.

8. Undefined Category Terms

Existing Board Rule 680-X-2-.05 already differentiates between chain pharmacies and independent pharmacies, and the schedules in proposed Chapter 680-X-A apply those existing, established categories rather than creating new or undefined ones.

9. Fiscal Note

Lastly, Commenter 2 argues that the fiscal note filed with the proposed rules "is internally contradictory." The fiscal note's statement that aggregate penalties are generally expected to decline, and its separate acknowledgment that no precise empirical model of the rule's impact is feasible, address different questions: a general directional expectation informed by the Board's enforcement experience, and a recognition that the qualitative public-health benefits of deterrence cannot be quantified on the same scale as monetary penalties. The two statements are not in genuine tension. The Board does expect that aggregate fines will be lower in future years than in past years. The Board cannot empirically quantify this expectation at this time.

IV. Conclusion

The Board has considered all written and oral submissions received in this matter. For the reasons stated above, the Board adopts proposed Rule 680-X-2-.50 and proposed Chapter 680-X-A as noticed on June 17, 2026, without change.
